

CALL TO ORDER

The general meeting of the Mustang Club of Central Pennsylvania was called to order at 6:30pm by President Bob Ardner on June 20, 2013, at L B Smith Ford in Lemoyne, Pennsylvania. There were 18 members present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said by the membership.

MINUTES:

The minutes of the May 16, 2013 meeting had been posted on the club website. A motion was moved by Fred Bucci and seconded by Kathy Armstrong to accept the minutes.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

The treasurer's report was distributed by Charlie Boyd. Charlie reported we made \$101.00 at the All Ford Nationals by selling a few of last years T shirts, stickers, one membership renewal and one brand new membership. A motion showing a balance of \$2,800.71 as of June 18, 2013 was moved by Fred Bucci and seconded by Barry Klunk to accept May and June reports as read.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

President Bob Ardner reported, for our webmaster, that the club's web hosting bill of 107.40 was incorrectly sent to Scott Sipe instead of our current webmaster, Bob Ardner III. A motion to allow Charlie to pay this bill was moved by Kathy Armstrong and seconded by Terry Weidemann.

MEMBERSHIP:

Charlie Boyd stated we had 66 paid members and 25 that need to be renewed. The membership decided to begin an EARLY BIRD DUES ENTICEMENT DISCOUNT PROGRAM. Beginning next year, the 15.00 yearly renewal dues cost will be expected no later then tax day...April 15...after April 15, the member will be dropped from the membership

roster. If the member wants to return to the membership, the yearly renewal dues will be 25.00. A motion to begin this new EARLY BIRD DUES ENTICEMENT DISCOUNT PROGRAM next year was moved by Jon Ruffner and seconded by Fred Bucci. This new program was also put in the new bylaw document.

ROUND UP:

Erin gave flyers to everyone who asked for them. Erin suggested we write a code on the bottom corner of the flyers so we know where our “customers” are coming from for the Round Up. Donation sheets were handed out to the members.

WEBSITE:

Anyone having a problem with our website is to contact the webmaster, Bob Ardner III immediately. The committee of Fred Bucci, Bob Ardner and Jon Ruffner presented their proposals on how the club should charge advertisers to be on our website.

Fred proposed automotive related \$200.00 per year and a 10% discount to all members. Also free samples for the members to try. Fred proposed nonautomotive related \$250.00 per year and a 10% discount to all members. The club will not charge L B Smith.....CJ's or American Muscle because they support the club. The advertisers will be reviewed every year. Bob Ardner III, the webmaster, is to check the website and links often. A motion was moved by Jon Ruffner and seconded by Fred Bucci to accept these advertising proposals. President Bob Ardner is to draft the wording and send to Terry Weidemann to put in our bylaws.

NEW BUSINESS:

Charlie and Erin Boyd will investigate the possibility of a storage unit for all the club supplies to be held in one location. Suggestions were made to make next years All Ford Nationals Tent even better then this year.....grill

food..sell T shirts ..decorate and go for the “best decorated tent” at the show....

OLD BUSINESS:

A motion was moved by Max Remington and seconded by Charlie Boyd to approve the new amended bylaws. Three amendments will be added and voted on at the next meeting. The new website advertising amendment, the early bird dues amendment and the type of officer amendment.

Terry Weidemann reported on the scholarship selection. Terry contacted HACC, Dauphin County Technical School and Cumberland Perry Area Vocational Technical School. The members decided on Cumberland Perry. The club decided to give \$250.00 to one automotive student. Terry will call the school and make the arrangements.

President Bob Ardner will contact the webmaster and have the logo changed on the club website.

We adjourned the general meeting at 7:30pm.
