

MUSTANG CLUB OF CENTRAL PENNSYLVANIA (MCCPA)
Minutes from the meeting on Thursday, April 16, 2015 at L.B. Smith Ford – Lemoyne, PA

The general meeting of the Mustang Club of Central Pennsylvania was called to order at 6:30 PM by President Charlie Boyd on April 16, 2015, at L.B. Smith Ford in Lemoyne, Pennsylvania. There were 28 members present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said by the membership.

Roundtable introductions were made.

Minutes from the March 19, 2015 general meeting had been posted on the website. A motion was moved by Dale Warner and seconded by Dennis Snyder to accept the minutes as posted.

The treasurer's report was distributed by Erin Boyd. Erin reported a balance of \$2,616.07 as of April 16, 2015. Joe Cressler mentioned that we bought a PA system. A motion was made by Joe Cressler and seconded by Barry Klunk to accept the report as read.

Erin Boyd reported the club has 161 members.

President, Charlie Boyd, reported that the club is growing. We have out grown LB Smith's conference room, and the club has reserved a community room at Giant on Trindle Road in Camp Hill for our meetings beginning in June from 5:30 PM – 9:00 PM. There is a \$75 fee for the room. Barry Klunk suggested letting Homer at L.B. Smith know of the change. Charlie agreed, and mentioned that MCCPA board meetings may still be held at L.B. Smith to maintain a relationship with the dealership.

Charlie reported that, as of the meeting, the membership roster is about 60% current in dues.

Dennis Snyder offered a tech tip for 2005 – 2008 mustangs. The boot on the brake cables may deteriorate, causing the brake lines to rust. He suggested having them checked.

Charlie suggested taking Muscle Car Mayhem flyers to spread the word of our show. Barry Klunk mentioned that the advertisement was in for the Hanover community paper.

Mike Cole addressed the Grumpy's Cruise happening Saturday, April 18, 2015. It is too late to RSVP. 43 people were signed up for the cruise, in 24 to 25 mustangs. Please meet at Sonic/Giant on Linglestown Road by 9:45 AM. We are scheduled at the museum at 11:30AM and at Grumpy's at 2:00 PM.

Charlie reported that Muscle Car Mayhem is May 9th at Performance Motors of Hanover. Members who want to help set up should arrive at 7:00 AM. A planning session has been scheduled for May 2, 2015 at Silver Spring Presbyterian Church from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM to cover the details of this show, and discuss other events.

Charlie reminded us that the Gate-N-Go for Carlisle Ford Nationals ends on May 4, 2015. Please designate "Mustang Club of Central PA" as your club affiliation when registering. Information will soon be sent regarding the picnic on Saturday of Ford Nationals.

Jon Ruffner addressed the New Member Meet and Greet / July 4th Picnic, which his family is hosting in East Berlin. Jon invites us to go for his favorite 2 hour cruise. Leave for the cruise around 2 PM, head from Jon's to Rt 15 South to Thurmont, MD, over the mountain towards Hagerstown, come back to PA via Waynesboro and Mt Alto, take 233 through the mountain, aka "black snake", stop at Fuller Lake. We then head back to Jon's for the picnic, bon fire, and fireworks. Jon suggested bringing a tent, and staying overnight, if you intend on consuming adult beverages.

Charlie explained the Round Up to our new members. It is September 5, 2015. There are 11 classes. Registration starts at 9 AM-1130 AM. Voting 11:30AM – 1PM. Exhaust Competition at 1:15 PM. Joe Cressler will be the MC for the exhaust competition. The Round Up will be a Mustang only show this year, as was decided in the planning sessions. Entertainment was decided to be a local radio station and a band, instead of a DJ. Jeff and Lorraine Turicik have volunteered to do the basket raffle. Jeff asked for donations towards the raffle in advance and another volunteer/s to help organize the event. The club need sponsors. Trophy sponsors are \$75 this year. We need a large corporate sponsor, like Latemodel Restoration and American Muscle. Jon Ruffner volunteered to contact American Muscle.

Charlie reported that when Dale Warner stopped in to talk to Appalachian Harley Davidson, they had invited Blue Moon Cruisers to display at the tailgate party instead, after we had already accepted their invitation. They offered us another event on June 20, 2015, but we already have Berk's County Mustang Club's show that day. We declined the alternate date.

Mike Cole explained the Covered Bridge Cruise (CBC) to the new members. The CBC will be October 25, 2015. The details regarding the CBC will be discussed at the planning session. If you have ideas about how to make the CBC better, please attend the session, or contact Charlie, Erin, or Mike.

Barbara Bloom asked about the Knoebel's cruise on July 25, 2015. Erin explained that the Knoebel's trip requires little planning. We meet up and ride together to the park. We enjoy the rides and entertainment inside. Last year the members all dined on chicken and waffles together.

The new meeting location previously mentioned is part of the new business. Our May meeting will be at L.B. Smith, all meetings after will be at Giant in Camp Hill. Terry Weidemann will contact Homer at L.B. Smith to let him know. She will also pick up a Thank You card for us to sign at the next meeting. Mike Cole asked for new L.B. Smith hats at the next meeting.

Dennis Snyder asked if the club was going to do dyno runs again. Nothing is currently planned, but if there is interest, it can be pursued. Barry Klunk and John Ruffner also recommended Keith Elledge as a dyno location.

Cruises, shows, and events are listed on the back of the meeting agenda.

Charlie reported that we purchased a Fender Conference PA System with tripods. The unit will be perfect for entertainment at the Mayhem Show and for award announcements at the Round Up.

Charlie adjourned the meeting at 7:43 PM.
