

## MCCPA GENERAL MEETING THURSDAY OCTOBER 20, 2016, CAMP HILL, PA

President Max Remington called the meeting to order at 7 PM and led everyone present in The Pledge of Allegiance. Round Table introductions were done. He stated that the monthly meeting minutes of 9/15/16 were posted to the club website and available for all to read. He then asked for a motion for approval, John Garner motioned and seconded by John Singer. Treasurer Jen Gamber gave treasurer's report and hard copies were available at the back table. Kathy Klunk asked about Hall's Ice Cream donation following Round Up. Discussion began and it seemed their sales may not have been strong. Jen reported that club total funds is \$8,260.54. A motion was made for approval which was made by Carlene Warner and seconded by Dale Warner. Jen then reported 285 members with 45 members needing to renew. Letters reminding them of cut off date were mailed and 3 responded that they would not be renewing. A motion was made by Joe Kessler to approve and Seconded by Barry Klunk. Jen reported that she had a copy of the point spread sheet and if interested you can see her to check it out. President's Report, Max reported that we had 50 events last year and grew in membership. The board will be working on better managing club finances to accommodate our active and growing club. This will include more regular board meetings and using accounting software. Jen is trying to track when and where we spend. The board has set a goal to sell Round Up and other sponsorships and ask for goodie bag items earlier this year.

Max then discussed old business and stated that for Mustang Round Up, if anyone has suggestions, or comments, please email John. Also please note what tasks you participated in at the Round Up. Jen has sent out thank you cards to all 2016 trophy sponsors. The Board has decided to keep all existing classes from 2016. We may still add another class. Possibly a Thunderbird Class. Round Up planning meeting in January and looking at York Motorcycle Club. Covered Bridge was then discussed. We have volunteers for registration, photo help, and parking. Dash plaques have been ordered. Check in from 8:15 AM to 9:15 AM. Ribbon colors, pink is counter-clockwise and green is clockwise. The Board will decide on points for helping; traffic, check in, etc. 25 points for helping.

Annual MCCPA Member Banquet and Elections are set for Saturday, November 12. The day will include meeting at the AACA Museum at 9:00 AM and the Banquet will be at the Hometown Family Restaurant from 12 PM to 3:00 PM. We will be electing new officers, voting on revised Bylaws. An option after the banquet would be to do Hershey Chocolate World Trolley.

### New Business

Bylaws – The Board has revised the Bylaws to better define membership fees and deadlines. The Bylaws will be mailed to all members to be voted on at the Banquet. Dues paid at a discount from January 1<sup>st</sup> – April 14<sup>th</sup>. On April 15<sup>th</sup> full membership price is charged. Also a

\$5.00 discount is offered to potential member under the age of 21. If signing up after Labor Day, membership includes the whole following year.

Delinquent letters will go out on April 15<sup>th</sup> and they will have 60 days to renew.

The forums -with MCCA website, Facebook and the newsletters it was felt that the forums are no longer relevant so we would like to shut form down. All approved shutting it down. If someone wants to sell something you can email John and it can be added to a newsletter.

The website will be updated in December with next year's meeting dates.

MCCA New Year's Eve Party will be at ABC West. We will be asking for sign ups after the Banquet. They will have a flyer out after Thanksgiving.
