

MCCPA GENERAL MEETING MAY 19, 2016 at GIANT MEETING ROOM, CAMP HILL, PA

The President's Report from Charlie Boyd began with the plaque that was presented to the club from NMRA and this was passed around for all to see. In addition the club received a \$600.00 check for running The Car Show which helped in purchasing the generator. Charlie reported that someone from Bright Side Baptist Church had contacted him about organizing a show on July 16th. There was little support due to short time frame and that this date interfered with Mustang Week. Secondly, an event at Olympic Skating Rink was proposed for consideration, along with a July 9th Parade in New Freedom. We will see if there is club interest in these events.

Old Business was next on the agenda. There were three suggestions for improving Spring Muscle Car Mayhem, start prepping food earlier, 10 a.m.; purchase better buns; and procuring better door prizes (this is true for all our shows). The Valley Forge Mustang Club Show on May 29th was next, we are currently tied for First in club registrations which will bring a \$100.00 prize to the club with highest registrations. An appeal for a club member to head up the cruise out to the show was made. Ford Nationals (June 2-5) was next event, members are encouraged to pre-register to save money, prevent long lines when entering, and are reminded to use MCCPA as club affiliation to help club place in top 3 for that competition. Cathy Klunk is heading up the picnic, so if you are attending on Saturday please contact Cathy and sign up for food item. Andy and Pat Bingaman have procured 21 bales of hay for the Barn Find Theme for free. Dale Warner will arrange delivery to the fairgrounds. Members are encouraged to wear bandanas and straw hats. We are meeting at the tent at 8 a.m. on Saturday. Greg Charles will provide cheese for burgers (Charlie happy) and he will drop off with Erin. Gary Golcher reports that John Clor will be presenting a talk on Mystic Mustangs on Saturday 2-3 p.m. Gary has numbers 1 and 24. New Member Meet & Greet scheduled for July 4th at Levitz Park in Grantville. Later will be a cruise to Denny & Diane's after for bonfire and fireworks. Mustang Week has one, possibly two openings at \$296 per person based on double occupancy. Membership renewals are now at \$25.00 for the year.

New Business: sewing event for handmade table covers is scheduled for May 23rd at 6 p.m. Back to The Fifties Classic Car Show proposed as an event to attend. Discussion of Leg Up Farm Car & Bike Show on June 25th. Club needs members to work the show, no pre registration, bring walkie talkies, getting participants in and parked timely is a priority.
