

MCCPA GENERAL MEETING JULY 21, 2016 at GIANT MEETING ROOM, CAMP HILL, PA.

Vice President Max Remington, acting in the absence of President Charles Boyd, called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. Max then led all in The Pledge of Allegiance, announced he was running the meeting due to Charlie & Erin being in Myrtle Beach, but present via phone, and began introductions.

Max then announced that May and June Meeting Minutes were posted to the website and asked for motions from the floor to accept. Dale Warner motioned for the May Minutes and Barb Bloom seconded. Diane Snyder motioned for the June Minutes with Rosemary Yakubowski seconding. Max then announced that hard copies of all reports, Agenda for this Meeting and all pertinent info were available on the table at the back of the room.

The Treasurer's Report showed total funds at \$1,754.88 with Gary Golicher motioning for acceptance and Ira Bloom seconding. The Membership Report from Jen Gamber shows 260 current members with 53 needing renewal. Charlie reported over phone that signed someone up at Myrtle Beach, and we should have two more locally, Dillsburg and Gettysburg. Max then read The Presidents Report, with the final number of cars, trucks, and bikes for The Leg Up Car Show coming in at 173. All were referred to Agenda.

Old Business began with Jeff & Lorraine reporting 16 donors, 5 from members, for The Round Up. Jeff has sent out letters to national businesses and has been in touch with Valley Forge Mustang Club, who is successful in recruiting this support for their show on Memorial Day Weekend. Dale suggested that to be successful, the club needs to begin this process very early in the year. It was noted we have one sponsor Dover Dairy Queen so far. We are still seeking swap meet vendors. Everyone is urged to print out flyers and circulate in businesses and wherever a cork board is to be found. The flyers can be printed out from website. There is a committee checking into a trailer for transporting items to shows. Dale states that we are seeking a 6' x 12' trailer. Gary suggested wwwcoparts for a good selection of trailers. Dennis reported that his company is still trying to sell their trailer, Dennis has suggested to them that if it was donated to club it would be tax deductible. Mike Cole reported that registration for The Covered Bridge Cruise is now open to MCCPA members, and will be opened to all starting on August 21. There are currently 57 registrations, with the cap at 100.

New Business: it is suggested holding 9/11 Picnic at Leg Up Farm. The Western Pa Cruise is still open to development, Erin has contact info for the Mustang Club in western Pa. Kim Welling volunteered to take this on. Jen Gamber suggested a cruise in at Sizzle & Chill, that this could lead to a regular event. She reports that there are 30-40 parking spots and that the owner is interested. Barb and Ira Bloom know the owner and report that he does the same with Blue Moon Cruisers.

Cruises/Shows/Other Events: Kim Welling suggested Bikers & Mustangs in the Pocono next Spring. Max ok'd as long as it does not conflict with any scheduled events. John Y noted a show on Saturday Helping Hometown Heroes in Littlestown which is posted on FB page. Barb asked who was heading up CJ Pony Show, it is Jim Nelson. All were encouraged to reference the Cruises/Shows/Other Events handout and to reference the club homepage.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
