

MCCPA GENERAL MEETING AUGUST 18, 2016 at GIANT MEETING ROOM, CAMP HILL, PA

President Charles Boyd called his last meeting to order at 7 p.m., led all in the Pledge of Allegiance, and initiated introductions. We will drop radio station idea. Erin presented a hard copy list of Car Show Checklist to aid us in organizing. Max will contact Cheryl about last year's directional signs or look into having new made. We will need a Order of The Day. Jen & Chris will print dash cards and other paperwork and purchase water. It was decided Barry Klunk, Mike Cole, Dan Fiorentino, and Bill Schiel will work the front gate. Joe will MC, Jeff Turicik will be in charge of Door Prizes, Millie & Terry will handle Club merchandise sales. Jen suggested we have club logo preprinted on Thank,

You cards to all Sponsors which can be taken up after the show. Members are asked to report at 7 a.m. to the Carlisle Fairgrounds. We need all member's help with this show.

New Business covered Fall Muscle Car Mayhem. Arrival and set up is 7 a.m. at Performance Motors. Terry, Millie and Rosemary will handle registration. Terry has dash cards etc. for 100+ entrants. We will order 100 hot dogs & buns based on previous shows. Bill to ask Dale Spahr if he can get free potato chips and if not Rosemary may be able to procure.
