

MCCPA General Meeting Saturday February 18, 2016 at Giant, Camp Hill, PA

President Max Remington called the meeting to order at 1:10 p.m., led all in The Pledge of Allegiance, and began Round Table introductions. This being the first meeting of 2017 there were no minutes to approve. Jen Gamber presented Treasurer's Report referring all to new hard copy (copies available to all at table) format, Quicken for Mac with page one being a summary page and pages 2-3 being item by item details. Insurance has been paid. Dennis Snyder motioned for approval, Ira Bloom seconded. Jen presented Membership Report, 250 members at this time. Jen explained color code on roster, Green = renewed members; Blue = awaiting renewal; Red = new members. Doug Zarker approved motion for approval, Jim Godwin seconded. President's Report: 2017 will be a great year, the club has been working to get a head start by having two Board Meetings and two Planning Meetings already. We have chosen a new t-shirt vendor that will allow members to order the size and color they desire. The link will be opened on March 1st on the Member's Page. Joe Grace from MCA has reported to Max that Covered Bridge article should be in March edition of Mustang Times. Both MCCPA and NMRA have signed the contract for the car show at Maple Grove. We will need 15 volunteers each day May 6-7 to help. Volunteers receive free admission to drag races and t-shirt. The club will make at least \$500. The members point system has been tweaked, non MCCPA event = 5 points, MCCPA event = 10 points, leading an event = 50 points. All info appears on website. The Board and Jeff Turicik have sent 93 sponsor mailings for Round Up, and Jeff has already received replies. The Board is working on sponsorship/new member packets for the 27 area Ford dealerships. Please sign up after the meeting to volunteer to hand these packets out if you a relationship with any of these dealers. The club has purchased a flag for smaller shows and group pics, and was used at Philly Auto Show. MCCPA member Glen Beck is now planning a cruise to Philly to visit The Simeone car collection. It appears that the Mustang Owners Museum will not be completed this year causing the change in plans. MCCPA taxes and insurance have paid for 2017.

New Business:

Bylaws- The Board is working on revisions, liaison for MCCPA and MCA being transferred from MCCPA Secretary to MCCPA Regional Director. Gary Golicher has agreed to continue in this position for 2017. The positions of MCA Liaison, Webmaster, and Membership Chairperson are non-officer positions specified in the bylaws. The defined VP roles are being reviewed. All revisions to the bylaws will be sent to all members fourteen days before the next general meeting.

Website- The website is up to date, VP John continues to add confirmed 2017 show dates; we are accepting 2017 membership renewals; Round Up registration and PayPal are live; the Ford Nationals link.

Spring Muscle Car Mayhem- waiting for confirmed date for Performance Motors. Max is building a winners backdrop to be used for trophy presentation pictures. We are still looking for help with an eight foot wide checkered banner.

Ford Nationals- Rich Klein had volunteered to get our Round Up flyers printed in time for them to be inserted into Ford Nationals goodie bags by Carlisle Productions. Max will email Ken Appel about tent size and cost. Last year the club had a 20x40 tent, we want to increase to 30x40 this year. We will order new 25th Anniversary banners which will be the theme this year. The picnic on Saturday will be catered by Horner'sCorner BBQ, and they will be at Round Up also. Tentative price for members will be \$9/person. Max will invite Valley Forge Mustang Club to participate. So that attending MCCPA members can receive giveaway items, we will be handing out goodie bags to those who sign in at the tent. Paul is looking into new giveaways, shifter balls with 25th Anniversary logo will return. We plan a group picture on Saturday at 11:30 a.m. before lunch.

Leg Up Farm Show- Bill and Paul have met with Jen Hitz and some adjustments will be made. LUF will prohibit pop ups and will take responsibility for enforcement. They will open the main hallway from front to back for access to bathrooms indoors, and pavilion, pond and playground in back. LUF has begun trophy assembly, and they will stuff goodie bags. Jen will have a finalized show flyer for us to hand out at Spring Mayhem.

Round Up- all 16 classes will remain including the Focus class. We removed SVT from class I and added ALL before Shelby's in class J. Max has contacted the two local Thunderbird clubs, and one has responded.

Possible Board Incentives- free membership renewal and MCA membership for 1 year. We would state this in bylaws for all Board Members. Members would vote at last meeting to approve for the following year.

Cruises/Shows/Other Events- VP John is always adding and updating the 2017 show calendar. All are invited to take a hard copy of the calendar available on the table with other forms and literature. Jim Godwin has a friend who is a drag racer at NMRA, we are invited into pits. Dennis Snyder suggested Walnut Grove Buffet restaurant for year end dinner. Barb Bloom is planning a Spring Cruise to Penns Cave and beyond for 4-29-17. Mike Cole is unable to head the annual Cruise to Grumpy's. Barb and Ira volunteered to lead CJ Pony Parts CAD.
