Jen Gamber presented the Treasurer's Report referring all to printed spreadsheet available for all present. Jen noted on page two a separate category for Ford Nationals breakout. Money for Horner's is broken out along with Twisted apparel account. NMRA does not appear, we are awaiting a mailed check. Any further questions regarding the report can be presented to Jen after the meeting. Dale Warner motioned to approve, John Garner seconded. Membership Report presented by Jen stated a total of 269 members, 26 new, 123 need renewals. After Ford Nationals a letter with self addressed stamped envelope for renewal will be sent. Max's President report stated that The Club is busy with planning for Ford Nationals with a thank you to all who registered under MCCPA. We have 101 registrations so the tent will be free. The event schedule will be Thursday set up, manning of the tent on Friday and Saturday from 8 am to 5 pm. Samples will be available at Ford Nationals along with order sheets. We will announce the next open ordering session. NEW BUSINESS: MCCPA members can make one off items using the MCCPA logos, however anything mass produced must have the approval of The Board. Please notify VP Paul Bellis of all such projects so we can keep track. Jeff Turicik reported on Round Up sponsors. He has received 16 responses so far and a second round of letters will go out to the 80 vendors who did not respond to first canvas. The Club received passes to Knoebels Park and we will award these at a drawing for new members at the Meet & Greet Picnic on July 1st. Despite cold and wet weather, The Club did make \$500 at NMRA this year. So we have run into bad weather both years, but the turnout of show cars was good. There is potential for a big pay day if the weather cooperates. The Board would like feedback if any members are interested in volunteer. If we don't get volunteers ahead of time we will hand the show over to Berk's County.

CRUISES/SHOWS/Other Events: The Club is looking for a lead person for May 27th 13th Annual Fireman's Festival and Country Cruise at Oregon Dairy and May 28th VFMC Chester County Mustang Show at Phoenixville where we have won best represented club the past two years which garners a cash prize for The Club. Also we have had multiple award winners in the past, and their basket raffle is super. VP John is constantly updating the 2017 event list, a print out of which is available to all attending, and we welcome all new shows but will give priority to an MCCA event and may not list another event if it falls on the day of our event.
