## Minutes

### 1. General

- Thank you notes for trophy sponsors - Paul will get the thank you notes for the Round Up trophy sponsors and bring them to the General Meeting on Saturday, 1/13. The Club has already sent thank you notes to other companies that donated.
- Vice President responsibilities – Chuck will handle updates to the show listings. Dates in italics on the current list have not been confirmed. Chuck will check website to confirm dates and search for other shows. Paul will continue to handle the newsletter and print items. Chuck will primarily handle Facebook, taking pictures at shows and sharing. Paul will also coordinate with Chuck on events.
- At the annual banquet and meeting, Denny Snyder inquired about depositing Club funds in an interest-bearing account. Max stated he will call the bank about interest rates. Max said we might be able to move the money during the offseason between the banquet and January. Most of the Club money comes in between January and June. Jen said she will call about a tiered account to find out if higher balances yield higher interest rates.
- MCCPA travel mugs – Max asked if we have enough mugs for new members for 2018. Paul will check with Noelle at Twisted about the possibility of changing the design.
- Member Points – Max suggests we keep the show and meeting sign ups. Ashley will handle the meeting sign ups. It is the members' responsibility to keep track of shows they attend.

### 2. Shows

- **2018 Philly Auto Show** - Max said the 2018 Philly Auto show runs from January 27 – February 4, 2018, and will not include breakfast this year. The club has 15 free tickets that will be handed out at the General Meeting on January 13, 2018.

- **Early spring cruise in Gettysburg (April 2018)** – Max asked Andy Bingham to design a Gettysburg cruise with a history twist. April 14 is the working date with a meet up at Performance Motors Cars and Coffee at 8 a.m., leaving at 9 a.m. This will also be our Mustang Day event. Max will ask Mike Cole if he wants to do a Grumpy’s cruise that Sunday.
- **Sizzle N Chill** – Max noted we need to decide on dates and leaders for the Sizzle N Chill events. The first two will be on Saturdays with the rest on Thursday nights.
- **2018 long cruise** – The Club would like to have an overnight cruise to either the Mustang Owner’s Museum in North Carolina, which likely won’t be ready in time, or Henry Ford Museum in Dearborn, MI, as suggested by Glen Beck. Max will ask about members’ interest at the next General Meeting.
- **Dillsburg Lions Club** – Paul advised that Jack Naylor from the Dillsburg Lions Club provided the dates of May 12 and 26 for a possible show. Our Club would help the Lions Club run the show. Jack is willing to come to our meeting or we can go to his meeting to work out the details. Muscle Mayhem is on May 12 so Paul will contact Jack to let him know that May 26 would be the date of the show.
- **Hunt Valley Cars and Coffee** – Max suggested the Club pick one Saturday to visit this event, which is held every Saturday morning at the Hunt Valley Mall.

### 3. Action Items for 2018

- Revised pamphlet – Paul noted the pamphlets are done. He just needs to change out the pictures. Paul will send the Board a PDF of the brochure.
- New business cards - Business cards were passed out and reviewed at a previous meeting.
- 2018 Board shirt design – Jen advised she sent the dates for Twisted T ordering in an email. She will resend. Paul suggested making baseball shirts or shop shirts available for purchase and will contact Twisted T regarding possible options for shirts.
- Muscle Mayhem flyer – Paul has started the design.
- Prepare 2018 ask for donation list – Max is working on this.
- Check dates for shows in 2018 – Chuck will handle.
- Facebook – Chuck will handle.
- Website – Max will handle.
- Newsletter – Paul is going to do the email newsletter on Wednesdays and then send a weekend update.
- Max will email the Berks County Mustang Club so we can get each other’s shows on the calendars.

#### **4. Event List**

- The Board next reviewed the events list and discussed changes.
- The Club will plan another trip to Hershey Sweet Lights Trolley in December.
- Max stated we need to look at locations of shows when adding them to the event list. The events on the current list are from last year. Dates need to be confirmed.
- All Markets at Hanover Car Shows will be removed from the list.
- The Board agreed to hold the MCCPA picnic on Saturday, June 30, since July 4 falls on a Wednesday this year.
- Round Up will have an open Ford class for now and any group with over 10 entries by the pre-registration date can have its own class.
- For the Capital City Car Wash Cruise In, Max will try to get a firm date from Scott earlier this year and also get a flyer.
- Max will start putting events on website. The Club needs help running events. The Club will talk about Ford Nationals at the upcoming planning meeting.
- Jen advised she will complete the taxes in March when the website is available.
- The Board also discussed possibly having a special shirt for members to wear at Round Up and a possible Club hat.
- Twisted-T will not have a club disbursement option this year so members will need to have orders delivered to their homes or pick up at Twisted-T. The Club logo is also registered with L.L. Bean.
- Jen advised the Club has \$6,000 in the bank account. 219 members still need to renew.
- Chuck and Ashley will get an MCA membership and let Jen know so she can reimburse the fee.
