1. General

- Thank you notes update for the trophy sponsors - Paul will get the notes to Jen ASAP.
- Update on Business cards, pamphlets and flyers - Paul will put in the order
- Paul is also checking with Twisted-T on not having set ordering times, more shirt options and other MCCPA branded items.
- Paul is nearly finished with the Mayhem Flyer. Will pass to Max soon. Max will contact Performance Motors to double-check the dates.
- Discussion of "Free MCCPA travel mug", options and cost - We had about 90 new members last year and the membership card cost about a \$1. The Board decided to change the new membership wording from free travel mug to free gift. The cost of free travel mug is too expensive to be cost effective for a new membership. We will look into the travel mugs Paul priced or perhaps even better quality for the members to purchase. Paul will price covered cups like Ashley suggested, key chains and other MCCPA branded items to give to new members. The items will also be used for giveaways at Ford Nationals.
- Jen will check in the storage unit for an inventory of items to be given away at Ford Nationals.
- Discussion of Member Points – Max suggested keeping show and meeting sign ups. It is the member's responsibility to keep track of the shows they attend. The Board agreed that the point system for 2018 will be simplified as follows:

2018 Point System:

MCCPA has a program that rewards members whom participate and lead MCCPA events.

The point system is similar to 2017. The big difference is the tracking. We found that tracking the earned points for every member was a much bigger task than we anticipated. So, for 2018, MCCPA members will be responsible to present their point total after the Round Up. We will still have sign ups at MCCPA events, but we will not be recording them through the year.

Points will be tallied before the Annual Banquet, and awards will be given at that time. Any points earned after the Annual Banquet will be credited to the next calendar year.

An Event is defined as a show, cruise or a gathering (like the Picnic). The MCCPA President will also award points for other contributions.

Points are earned as follows:

10 pts = Attend MCCPA Event or Meeting

25 pts = Helping at a MCCPA Event

50 pts = Lead an Event*

*The Event needs to be approved by a MCCPA board member.

Awards for points accumulated are:

100 pts = Free small MCCPA gift

250 pts = Free MCCPA T-Shirt

350 pts = \$50 Parts Gift Card

500 pts = \$50 Parts Gift Card and Free 2018 MCCPA Renewals

- Ken Appell says we are good for the September 1 Round Up date and putting our flyers in the Ford Nationals Goodie bags.
- As of 1/23, we had 38 cars signed up for the Ford Nationals.
