1. **Call to Order**

President Max Remington called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led all present in the Pledge of Allegiance and began Round Table introductions.

2. **Approval of Minutes of January 13, 2018**

Max announced the minutes from the January 13, 2018, meeting were posted on the Club website for review and called for their approval.

It was **MOVED** by Bill Schiel, seconded by Laura Campagne-Gregorits and carried that the minutes be approved as presented.

3. **Treasurer's Report**

Jen Gamber presented the Treasurer's Report, hard copies of which were available for all present at the meeting. She noted she renewed the Club's Post Office box for another year.

It was **MOVED** by Laura Campagne-Gregorits, seconded by Ira Bloom and carried that the Treasurer's Report be approved as presented.

4. **Membership Report**

Jen continued with the Membership Report. She noted hard copies were available for review by those present at the meeting and the report was also posted on the Club website. Jen stated the club currently has 269 members, with 175 yet to renew.

5. **President's Report**

Max began by noting that April starts the busy season and more members are needed to help with events.

Max reminded members that the Contact page on the website goes directly to him in case anyone wants to contact him and cannot remember his email address. The members page username is MCCPA^members and the password is PonyFun2016! The login is case sensitive. Max changes the header color and member bio weekly. He requested that members send bios to him to be included on the website, including the year and color (note if metallic) of the member's Mustang

Max stated the Club needs help organizing and taking pictures at events. He requested that members attending a show send pictures to him or other Board members to add to the Facebook page and MCCPA website. Four events are scheduled for June 16th so pictures from members will especially be needed on that day.

6. Old Business

Max reminded members that help is still needed in 2018 for the following positions:

- Property Management – To keep track of the storage unit, including getting items from the storage unit in Carlisle to shows not at the Fairgrounds.
- Show Management – To help run larger shows. Max noted help is needed at bigger shows like Ford Nationals to provide coverage and free up the Board.

Barry and Cathy Klunk are leading the Sizzle-N-Chill events but help is needed for other events. Laura Campagne-Gregorits volunteered to help with shows on weekends when she's not working.

Max reminded everyone that Carlisle Events is providing a 10% discount for Ford Nationals and other events through April 30. Members registering for the Ford Nationals should select MCCPA as the Club. Directions for how to do this are posted on the members page of the MCCPA website. In 2016, 100 members registered and selected MCCPA so the Club got the largest tent for free.

7. New Business

Continuing, Max reminded everyone that the next Planning Meeting is on Saturday, April 28, at the York Motorcycle Club. At the meeting, the Club will be finalizing plans for Muscle Mayhem and preparing for the Dillsburg Lions Club show and Ford Nationals. The Club is not planning to do a theme at Ford Nationals this year. Horners will be catering lunch again. The cost will be \$10 per person. The deadline to sign up is May 19. Anyone interested in attending should contact Max or Jen. Cathy Klunk inquired about pricing for small children. Max advised there is currently no special pricing for children but members should let Max know if they're bringing any kids age 5 or under.

In 2018, MCCPA will continue to use Twisted-T as its apparel supplier. A schedule will be set up for orders in 2018 and a link to the website is on the members' page. Paul said he is working on other merchandise options such as mugs, baseball jerseys, and shop shirts. The giveaway for Ford Nationals will be a keychain, which will also be available for purchase through Twisted-T. If members have other items they would like

to see, they should contact Paul. Max reminded everyone that MCCPA also has an L.L. Bean direct business account. Members should contact Max if they see anything they want.

Max concluded with a review of the revised member points system for 2018. The Board will not be maintaining a spreadsheet this year. Instead, the Club will have signups at car shows and meetings. Members leading shows will need to keep track of who attended and who led the events. Members will be responsible for submitting their point totals after Round Up.

Points will be tallied before the Annual Banquet, and awards will be given at that time. Any points earned after the Annual Banquet will be credited to the next calendar year.

An Event is defined as a show, cruise or a gathering (like the Picnic). The MCCPA President will also award points for other contributions.

Points are earned as follows:

10 pts = Attend MCCPA Event or Meeting

25 pts = Helping at a MCCPA Event

50 pts = Lead an Event*

*The Event needs to be approved by a MCCPA board member.

Awards for points accumulated are:

100 pts = Free small MCCPA gift

250 pts = Free MCCPA T-Shirt. - Base t-shirt at Twisted-T

350 pts = \$50 Parts Gift Card

500 pts = \$50 Parts Gift Card and Free 2018 MCCPA Renewals

8. Cruises/Shows/Other Events

Max referenced the events list, which includes dates for the Giant general meetings, planning meetings, board meetings and MCCPA events. All dates have been confirmed for MCCPA events. Members should let Chuck know of shows to be added to the list, as long as they do not conflict with MCCPA events. Any other ideas of where to post shows can also be sent to Chuck.

- **Grumpy's Cruise** – Mike Cole is leading this event on April 15. Mike relayed that the event will begin with a cruise from Harrisburg to Jim Thorpe, followed by a ride on the Lehigh Gorge Scenic Railroad and a cruise to Grumpy's BBQ. Mike will soon have more information soon about meeting places and times. Train tickets need to be ordered and paid for in advance to get the group discount.
- **Spring Cruise** - Max stated the Club would like to do a long cruise to Henry Ford Museum in Dearborn, MI, but Glen Beck isn't available until later in the season. The cruise to Grumpy's BBQ will be the Club's spring cruise this year. Barb and Ira Bloom will not be planning a separate spring cruise but will still do the annual banquet and Sweet Lights.

- **AACA** – Barb and Ira’s car will be on display at the AACA museum. AACA has asked if the Club can come to the opening. Max will confirm the date of the car show and the date the cars will go on display.

Max next reviewed upcoming shows of interest.

- **Saturday, April 7, Sizzle-N-Chill**, – The first cruise in is April 7. The Club will be enjoying the new breakfast menu.
- **Saturday, April 14, Gettysburg Cruise** – Andy Bingham will be hosting a cruise through the Gettysburg battlefield. The meet up is at Performance Motors Cars and Coffee in Hanover, with an alternate meet up location at the Gettysburg Visitors Center. This is the Mustang Day event. Members should contact Max if attending.
- **Tuesday, April 17, ACA Cruise to CJ’s** – Paul advised this event is free but they’re asking attendees to register. There’s a link on the MCCPA website. The event will begin at the AACA museum with cars and coffee, then proceed to CJ’s for a tour followed by a cruise. Max noted Spring Carlisle is also that week.
- **Sunday, April 29, Drive Your Dreams** – This show is presented by SVCC and held at the Ceramic Pro Auto Spa in Manheim. The flyer is on the website. Max’s birthday wish is to win the best club award at this Camaro show.
- **Saturday, May 5, Cumberland Valley Vo Tech** – Car show is on May 5 from 9-2 pm with a rain date of May 12. The flyer is on the website. Max will be presenting the scholarship check for \$500 and would like the Club to have several cars there as well.
- **Saturday May 12, Muscle Mayhem 2018** - Rain date of July 14.
- **Sunday May 13, Sizzle -N- Chill Cruise In** - 12-2pm
- **Saturday, May 19, Hunt Valley Horsepower** - Show is every Saturday morning at the Hunt Valley Towne Centre from 8-10 am. Max is leading this event.
- **Saturday, May 26, Dillsburg Lions Car Show** – This is the Lions Club’s first car show and will be held at Hope Grace Brethren Church. The Club will help run this show, similar to what it does for the Leg Up show. Paul is working on getting more information and a flyer.
- **Sunday, May 27, Chester County Mustang, (Valley Forge)** - Max will try to get someone to lead. Erin and Charlie are coming to this show.
- **June 1-3, Carlisle Ford Nationals.**

Max stated headcounts are needs for the cruises on 4/14 and 4/15.

Max requested that members write bios and tell him if you see your car on the website, noting which event and where on the site. Bios can be sent to Max through the contact page on the website.

Dale Warner provided information on other shows not on the events list.

Max will contact Glen Beck about the cruise to Michigan. Next year the Club will plan to go to the Mustang museum in North Carolina.
