1. Call to Order

President Max Remington called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He led all present in the Pledge of Allegiance and began roundtable introductions.

2. Approval of Minutes of September 20, 2018

Max announced the minutes from the September 20, 2018, meeting were posted on the Club website for review and called for their approval.

Additionally, volunteers are still needed to help organize meet ups for shows as well as to take pictures for Facebook and the MCCPA website.

6. Old Business

Max continued with the following updates:

- **2019 MCCPA officers** - Members are needed to fill the positions of President and Vice President for 2019 in order to continue the club. Carlene Warner has agreed to head the nominating committee. Lorraine Turicik has volunteered to handle the membership role. Max explained that the Board is looking at expanding the size to include more jobs. The 2019 Board may elect to add more board positions for other jobs. Doing so will require a revision to the Bylaws.
- **MCCPA Merchandise** - MCCPA will continue to use Twisted-T as its apparel supplier. The Club has paid a fee to keep the link open all year. MCCPA also has an L.L. Bean direct business account.
- **2018 Covered Bridge Cruise** – This year's cruise will be held on Sunday, October 28, 2018. Registration is now open to anyone. Members can sign up on the website or by paper registration form. All 100 slots are expected to sell out. The registration link will be shut down on the morning of Saturday, October 20th. Max reviewed the details of the Trunk or Treat event and dinner the night before the cruise.
- **Final Meeting/Banquet** – The banquet is scheduled for Saturday, November 10, at 2 pm at Hoss's in Hummelstown. Barb Bloom is leading. John Clor from Ford Performance will be at the Banquet. Other activities will include Mustang trivia and 2018 point awards.
- **Sweet Lights Trolley** - On December 2, The Club will again be holding the Hershey Sweet Lights Trolley. This year the slots are limited so members must sign up in advance and cannot be accommodated the day of. Six spots were available as of the meeting.

7. New Business

Max relayed that the Club will be donating \$3,000 plus the proceeds from the Detroit Steel Show to Leg Up Farm as well as a \$500 scholarship to an auto tech senior at Cumberland Perry Area Vocational Technical School (CPAVTS). The Club will present the check to Leg Up Farm at the banquet and will present the check and membership at the CPAVTS graduation in late May 2019.

Max ordered 50 stickers for Mustang Day 2019, which is on Wednesday, April 17th. The Club normally has two cruises the weekend before, one of which is Grumpy's BBQ. Mike Cole suggested a cruise to the Classic Auto Mall in Morgantown on Saturday, April 13th, as the Auto Mall is closed on Sunday. Max advised the Board would discuss this at the next board meeting.

On Saturday, October 20, Doug Zarker will be leading MCCPA members on a cruise to the Flight 93 Memorial in Shanksville, PA. Meetups will be at Middlesex Diner at 8:30 am and Sheetz in McConnellsburg at 10:40 am, arriving at the Memorial around noon. The group will leave the Memorial at 3:00 pm and head to dinner at the Jean Bonnet Tavern in Bedford, PA.

On Sunday, the Club will be heading to the Cabela's Car Show to Benefit Disabled Veterans, presented by Berks Mustang Club. Meetups will be at Sizzle-N-Chill, leaving at 7:50 am, and McDonald's in Hamburg near Cabela's, heading to the show at 8:45 am. The show is also a trunk or treat.

Max reviewed the general meeting dates scheduled for 2019 at the Giant in Camp Hill.
