1. Call to Order

Following the annual dinner, President Max Remington called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. and led all present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Approval of Minutes of October 18, 2018

Max announced the minutes from the October 18, 2018, meeting were posted on the Club website for review and called for their approval.

3. Treasurer's Report
