1. **Call to Order**

President Max Remington called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led all present in the Pledge of Allegiance and began Round Table introductions.

2. **Approval of Minutes of May 17, 2018**

Max announced the minutes from the May 17, 2018, meeting were posted on the Club website for review and called for their approval.

It was **MOVED** by Bill Schiel, seconded by John Singer and carried that the minutes be approved as presented.

3. **Treasurer's Report**

Jen Gamber presented the Treasurer's Report, hard copies of which were available for all present at the meeting. She noted the Club is starting to get pre-registrations for the Covered Bridge Cruise and Round Up. Expenses for the period included the game of chance license and money to purchase items for the basket raffle for Round Up.

It was **MOVED** by Barb Bloom, seconded by Gene Wiehagen and carried that the Treasurer's Report be approved as presented.

4. **Membership Report**

Jen continued with the Membership Report. She noted hard copies were available for review by those present at the meeting and the report was also posted on the Club website. Jen stated the club currently has 305 members, with 120 yet to renew. She noted final renewal letters were sent on June 19 and anyone who does not renew will be removed from the roster after 30 days.

5. President's Report

Max reported that since the last meeting, the Club attended Ford Nationals, ran the Dillsburg Lions show, and covered four shows over the previous weekend. Signups are currently being held to help with the Leg Up Farm show and to attend the MCCPA picnic.

As at previous meetings, Max stated that members looking to contact him should email or call. The Contact page on the website goes directly to his email. He asked that members not send messages by Facebook as he does not check it frequently. The members page username is MCCPA^members and the password is PonyFun2016!

Max reminded everyone that volunteers are still needed to help organize meet ups for shows as well as to take pictures for Facebook and the MCCPA website. He thanked those who took pictures at shows the previous weekend.

Lastly, Max stated Haar's Drive-In would be featuring the movie Grease that night.

6. Old Business

Max reported that Doug Zarker is the new Property Manager but help is still needed for the Show Management position.

With regard to 2019 MCCPA officers, Paul Bellis has reached his term limit and cannot run for Vice President next year. Max has served two years as President and is stepping down but will continue to run the website. Members are needed to fill the positions.

Max asked anyone with feedback about Ford Nationals to email him. For next year, the Club discussed having a theme, but no costumes, and asked for feedback about having a Club shirt. Max noted the Club finished 3rd in participation and asked for suggestions for getting more Club members to sign up.

Also at Ford Nationals, John Clor, Enthusiast Communications Manager for Ford Performance visited the Club tent. Max is in communication with Trent at Ford Performance regarding an appearance by John at either Round Up or the annual banquet, as well as Ford's new club connect program on its website.

Max stated MCCPA will continue to use Twisted-T as its apparel supplier. The Board has authorized a fee to keep the link open all year. MCCPA also has an L.L. Bean direct business account.

The Club has new merchandise which Max will be bringing to meetings and certain events. Keychains are \$10, cups \$4, magnetic clips \$1 and notepad and pens are free. Anyone with interest should see Max before or after a meeting.

Max was also contacted by David Morton from the Mecum Harrisburg 2018 auction. Mecum has a car club program and will be sending flyers and providing Max with more information. They will also be providing goodie bags for Round Up.

Max reiterated that volunteers are needed to help with the Leg Up Farm show. The volunteers were as follows:

7. New Business

Round Up

- Bill Schiel suggested an activity for Round Up such as a Hot Wheels competition with heats and elimination races.
- Max reviewed the vendors for Round Up. SNSCROFTGATE, Bootleg Creamery and Doug Philips of "what an impression" will be attending. Horners BBQ will be selling breakfast and lunch.
- Round Up is now an all Ford event. Mustang Round Up and Ford flyers are available. The MCA insurance letter and the games of chance license have been completed.

Max reported the Board decided to offer a free membership to the CPAVTS student winner of the MCCPA scholarship.

Max emailed Lisa Leathery about the Club attending the July 7 SAAC event at the Farm Show. He will try to find another date if she does not confirm soon.

MCCPA and Susquehanna Valley Camaro Club are co-hosting a Camaro vs. Mustang car show at the Ceramic Pro Auto Spa in Lancaster on September 29. Max will work with Ken from SVCC on this when he returns from vacation.

The Club will be purchasing an ad in the Grantville Fire Company book.

8. Cruises/Shows/Other Events

Max highlighted the upcoming shows on the event calendar. He noted he would like to have a good showing at the Cabela's Fall Show presented by Berks County Mustang Club on July 21. That club's President is also a member of MCCPA.

9. Other Business

Barry Klunk commented that Mecum Auto Auctions is a major sponsor for MCA and offers free entry into shows for MCA members. Mecum will be at the Farm Show in the first week of August.

Chris Gamber suggested having more Leg Up Farm flyers to distribute at Thunder on the River next year. This year, the show had 500 preregistered participants.
