1. **Call to Order**

President Max Remington called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led all present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. **Approval of Minutes of July 19, 2018**

5. President's Report

Before the next meeting, the Club will have held the Mustang Round Up and Ford show on September 1 and the Detroit Steel Show on September 8.

6. Old Business

Max continued with the following updates:

- **2019 MCCPA officers** - Paul Bellis has reached his term limit of four years as per the Bylaws and cannot run for Vice President next year. Max has served two years as President and three years as Vice President. He will be stepping down but will continue to run the website. Members are needed to fill the positions. These roles need to be filled to continue the club. Carlene Warner has agreed to head the nominating committee.
- **MCCPA Merchandise** - MCCPA will continue to use Twisted-T as its apparel supplier. The Club has paid a fee to keep the link open all year. MCCPA also has an L.L. Bean direct business account.
- **Mustang Round Up and Ford Show**
 - At the Markets at Shrewsbury Cruise In on August 24, the Club will be handing out Round up and Detroit Steel flyers. The makeup date is August 31.
 - Max reported that the Club has received donations and sold out the trophy sponsorships for Round Up. Preregistration is open until August 26. Mustang Round Up and Ford flyers are available. The Club has been advertising the show in local papers and on car show websites.
 - John Clor will not be able to attend Round Up. The show will have a Hot Wheels challenge and an exhaust competition.
 - The Club is talking to Stang Magazine about doing an edition of the magazine for Round Up. Paul has ordered a paper copy of the American Muscle edition of the magazine so members can see the print quality.
 - At the Planning Meeting on Sunday, August 26 from 1-4 pm at the York Motorcycle Club, members will be putting together goodie bags and going over final details.

- Max reviewed the schedule of events and sponsors for Round Up. He noted help is still needed for several positions.

7. New Business

MCCPA, Susquehanna Valley Camaro Club and Modern Mopar Club are co-hosting the Detroit Steel Show at Ceramic Pro Auto Spa in Lancaster on September 8 from 1-5 pm. A few volunteers are needed to help with registration and parking.

The annual Knoebels trip was rained out again and has been rescheduled for Sunday, October 7. The park will have a Halloween theme and wrist bracelets will be available. The Club will discuss logistics at the next general meeting. Anyone with suggestions for meet up places should email Max.

MCCPA and Mike Cole announced the signup for the 2018 Covered Bridge Cruise to be held on Sunday, October 28, 2018. Registration is now open to anyone. Members can sign up on the website or by paper registration form. All 100 slots are expected to sell out.

Max has signed up the Club on the Ford Performance Enthusiast club connect link.

The final meeting/Banquet is on November 10. Barb Bloom is handling the planning. She advised the banquet will be held at Hoss's in Mechanicsburg at 2 pm. John Clor is scheduled to attend.

8. Cruises/Shows/Other Events

Max reviewed the upcoming shows on the event calendar. He asked for a volunteer to lead the Sizzle-N-Chill Cruise In on September 13. Barb and Ira bloom agreed to lead if another member can set up the tent and PA system.
