**1. Call to Order**

President Paul Bellis called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He led all present in the Pledge of Allegiance and began roundtable introductions.

**2. Approval of Minutes of March 21, 2019**

Paul announced the minutes from the March 21, 2019, meeting were posted on the Club website for review and called for their approval.

It was **MOVED** by Laura Campagne-Gregorits, seconded by Diane Snyder, and carried that the minutes be approved as presented.

**3. Treasurer's Report**

Jen Gamber presented the Treasurer's Report, hard copies of which were available for all present at the meeting. She reported the Club received numerous renewals since the last meeting and did not disburse any monies during the period.

It was **MOVED** by John Garner, seconded by Barb Bloom and carried that the Treasurer's Report be approved as presented.

**4. Membership Report**

Lorraine Turicik followed with the Membership Report. She reported that the Club added seven new members, with 132 renewals, bringing the total to 274 members.

## 5. President's Report

Paul reported that the Club held Mustang Day events on Saturday, April 13, and Wednesday, April 17. On Saturday, the Club cruised to Yoder's Country Market for breakfast and then toured the Classic Auto Mall in Morgantown, followed by a cruise to Grumpy's for dinner. On Wednesday, the Club cruised to Sizzle-N-Chill for breakfast and then to the AACA Museum in Hershey. After a stop for lunch, members cruised to the Eastern Museum of Motor Racing in York Springs.

## 6. Old Business

Paul continued with the following updates:

- **MCCPA 2020 Calendar** – Paul recapped the plans for the calendar, explaining that the calendar will likely be for 16 months from September 2019 through the end of 2020. In order to offset costs, members will be asked to pay a small fee to have their cars featured in the calendar. The calendar should be completed in time for delivery by Round Up. He noted the sign-up for the calendar would be cut off after the meeting,
- **MCCPA Survey** – Paul stated that he will be sending out a survey to gather input and suggestions from members in order to increase participation at events and meetings. He will likely put the survey online with a link in the newsletter.

## 7. New Business

- **Changes to Bylaws** – Paul reported that the Board is recommending several changes to the Bylaws. Hard copies of the revised Bylaws were available at the meeting for review by the members. He noted the changes would also be sent via email and posted on the website. Members will vote on the changes at the general meeting in May.
- **Mustang Club Apparel** – Paul stated he is continuing to work on ideas for new apparel. Club apparel will now be printed three times per year. A sign-up sheet should be available in May so the apparel can be printed in June.
- **MCCPA Business Cards and Flyers** – Paul reported that the new business cards have been designed and he continues to work on designing the flyers.

## 8. 2019 General Meeting Dates

Paul reviewed the general meeting dates scheduled for 2019 at the Giant in Camp Hill. He noted the three meetings in June, July and August will be held on Wednesday night.

## **9. 2019 Planning Meeting Dates**

Paul next reviewed the remaining general meeting dates, noting the meetings will be held on Wednesday nights from June through August, The Club will hold one planning meeting in August to assemble goodie bags for Round Up.

## **10. Cruise/Shows/Other Events**

Paul began by noting that Club member Joe Blessing recently passed away. Joe started the Club in his garage in 1992. Paul shared the details of the viewing and funeral services.

Paul continued with a review of upcoming shows on the event calendar. He asked members to let the Board know of any shows, cruises or other events to be added to the list.

- April 27 – 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Family Ford Car Show – Family Ford is a Round Up sponsor so the Club will be helping with registration and parking.
- May 25 – Rock solid Car Show at Hope Grace Church in Dillsburg –This will be a free show, with no registration fee or cost for food. The church is hoping to bring in at least 100 cars for this event.
- May 31-June 2 – Carlisle Ford Nationals – The Club currently has 82 members registered for this event. The Club has purchased the large tent and will be reimbursed the tent fee is 100 members are registered before the show date. Horners will be providing lunch, with a cost of \$10 for members registered for Ford Nationals under MCCPA and \$15 for other non-registered members to offset the cost of the tent. Volunteers will be needed for the tent, with shifts of about 1-2 hours. Sign-up sheets for lunch and volunteers will be provided at the next general meeting.
- June 8 – LCBC Car Show – Rich and Scott from LCBC explained that the show is in its 20<sup>th</sup> year and is featuring Mustangs this year. John Clor will be in attendance, plus there will be door prizes, food and RC cars. Volunteers are needed to park cars and will receive a free meal ticket to Hess BBQ for helping. If Club members pre-register, LCBC can identify members so the group can be parked together.
- June 22 – Leg Up Farm Show – The registration fee this year will be \$15 and Leg Up will have one food vendor. The Club will handle registration and parking as usual.
- June 29 – Annual MCCPA Member Picnic – Peggy and Sonny Gamber will be hosting this event again this year. As in prior years, the Club will provide fried chicken and members will be asked to bring a covered dish.
- August 31 – Mustang Round Up and Fords show – Lorraine Turicik stated that members can start donating items for this year's basket raffle at any time. She also requested members donate empty baskets in good condition.

**11. Other Business**

Kathy Armstrong noted that the AACA and EMMR museums are looking for volunteers.

The next meeting is Thursday, May 16, at Giant in Camp Hill.
