#### 1. **Call to Order**

Vice President Chuck Sennett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He led all present in the Pledge of Allegiance and began roundtable introductions.

#### 2. **Minutes of June 19, 2019**

Chuck announced the minutes from the June 19, 2019, meeting were posted on the Club website for review and called for their approval.

#### 4. **Membership Report**

Jeff Turicik followed with the Membership Report. He reported that the Club has received 152 renewals and added 40 new members to date, bringing the total membership to 277.

#### 5. **President's Report/Old Business**

Chuck reviewed the following club activities:

- **Rock Solid Auto Show** - This show was held at Hope Grace Church in Dillsburg on May 25 and brought in over 140 cars. The Church plans to hold the show again next year on Memorial Day weekend.
- **Ford Nationals** – Chuck reported the Club finished just outside of 3<sup>rd</sup> place for the club challenge. He stated the Club purchased 150 meals but distributed just over 100 wristbands and plans to decrease the number of meals ordered next year. Chuck noted members liked the raffle as well as the change to the volunteer scheduling.

- **Mustang Club Apparel** – Chuck reported the new apparel is expected to be ready for ordering in July. Performance and regular t-shirts will be available and a flyer will be posted on the website. Pictures of apparel were included in the most recent Club newsletter. Club members can still order from the Twisted T website as well.
- **Cruise Ideas** – Chuck asked members to notify the Board with any ideas for cruises. He reminded members that the Club will be stopping at Bob Wert's house as part of the cruise before the annual banquet.

Jeff Turicik suggested a cruise to the Piper Museum in Lock Haven. The museum is approximately 140 miles from Club headquarters. Jen Gamber noted the current insurance limits cruises to 100 miles one-way. She will look into the cost for a policy rider for this cruise.

Chuck relayed that the Board also discussed possible cruises to Gettysburg and various car museums as well as a poker run.

## **6. New Business – Round Up**

Chuck reminded members that volunteers are needed for Round Up to help with registration, parking, the basket raffle and auction. Bob Wert volunteered to provide the music for the event. Trophy sponsors are also needed. Jen noted hard copy trophy sponsorship forms were available at the meeting and are also posted on the Links page of the website. She added that Round Up registration is now open. Jeff reported that 16 baskets have been prepared and he has numerous items for the auction. Chuck noted a planning meeting will be held at the York Motorcycle Club on August 25, 1-3pm, to assemble goodie bags for Round up.

Chuck reviewed the upcoming shows on the event calendar.

## **8. Other Business**

Chuck reported the Covered Bridge cruise is open just for Club members right now and is getting close to the limit of 100 registrations. He noted the Club will be asking for volunteers as the cruise gets closer.

Bob Wert inquired about a possible car show at Williams Grove. Jen noted the Club has talked about having Round Up at a different location so this may be a possibility. Bob agreed to look into it.
