1. **Call to Order**

President Paul Bellis called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He led all present in the Pledge of Allegiance and began roundtable introductions.

2. **Minutes of July 17, 2019**

Paul announced the minutes from the July 17, 2019, meeting were posted on the Club website for review and called for their approval.

5. **President's Report**

6. **Old Business**

- **Round Up** – Paul reminded members that hard copy trophy sponsorship forms were available at the meeting and are also posted on the Links page of the website. He noted Horner's BBQ will be at the show again this year; however, What an Impression will not.

Paul stated that volunteers are needed for registration, parking, front gate, basket raffle and auction.

7. New Business

- **Cruise Ideas** – Paul noted at the last meeting the Club discussed cruise ideas such as the Garden Railway and the Piper Museum. He suggested an historical cruise in Gettysburg, possibly during peak fall foliage and asked that members contact any board members with any ideas for cruises.

- **MCCPA Final Meeting and Banquet** – Members agreed that the Club will leave for the pre-banquet cruise at 10:00 a.m., returning to Hoss's at 2:00 p.m. The room at Hoss's is reserved from 2-7 p.m. The meeting will be held first with food and games afterward. Paul noted he would also like member to bring a donation, likely for Toys for Tots.

10. Other Business

Barb Bloom stated the Sweet Lights Trolley is booked for Saturday, December 14th. Member agreed to meet at Sizzle-N-Chill at 2:00 p.m., with the trolley ride at 6:00 p.m. Registration will be limited to 44 members and Jen Gamber will collect money the day of the ride.

Lorraine reported the Club currently has 20 baskets for Round Up and asked that any members bringing donations the day of the show let her know what they're bringing ahead of time. Jeff added the Club will also have 10-15 silent auction items. He noted items are still needed for goodie bags. The Club will be making 100 bags for Round Up. Paul noted Round Up awards will be acrylic trophies for 1st place and plaques for 2nd and 3rd places. Sheetz gift cards will be awarded to the winners of exhaust competition. He added that volunteers should arrive at 7:00 a.m. and Horners will be selling breakfast again this year.

Paul noted that all 50/50 and basket raffle money from Round Up is donated to Leg Up. He suggested doing a poker run next year with the proceeds going to a different charity.

Mike Cole asked for someone to lead the Covered Bridge cruise in the opposite direction and Tim Baker volunteered. Mike also asked that members let him know if they know of any events happening the night before the Covered Bridge Cruise in the Northern Lancaster/Southern Berks county area.
